

Where is it?

The venue is The High Leigh Conference Centre. High Leigh is set in the heart of the Hertfordshire countryside with 40 acres of tranquil lawns, parkland and woodland. Its helpful staff and high quality facilities make it an ideal venue for our conference.

Bedroom accommodation consists mainly of single and twin-bedded rooms. There are a few larger rooms.
